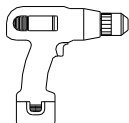


IMPORTANT:

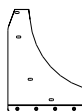

INSTALLATION

For ease of installation, it is suggested that the wheel be removed.

1. Before you install your mud flap set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Cut protective plastic and peel away from stainless steel. Start on the driver's side.
2. Square the flap with the tire while holding the flap up against the wheel well.
3. Ensure the 4 slotted holes on the stainless steel panel are centered on the wheel well and the slots in the stainless steel panel cannot be seen from the rear of the truck.
4. Fasten the flap with the 4 tek screws and washers into the 4 slotted holes.

✓ Check all fasteners for tightness. Repeat procedure on the other side.
